A solution for publishing, e-archiving and long term preservation of research and environmental data at SLU

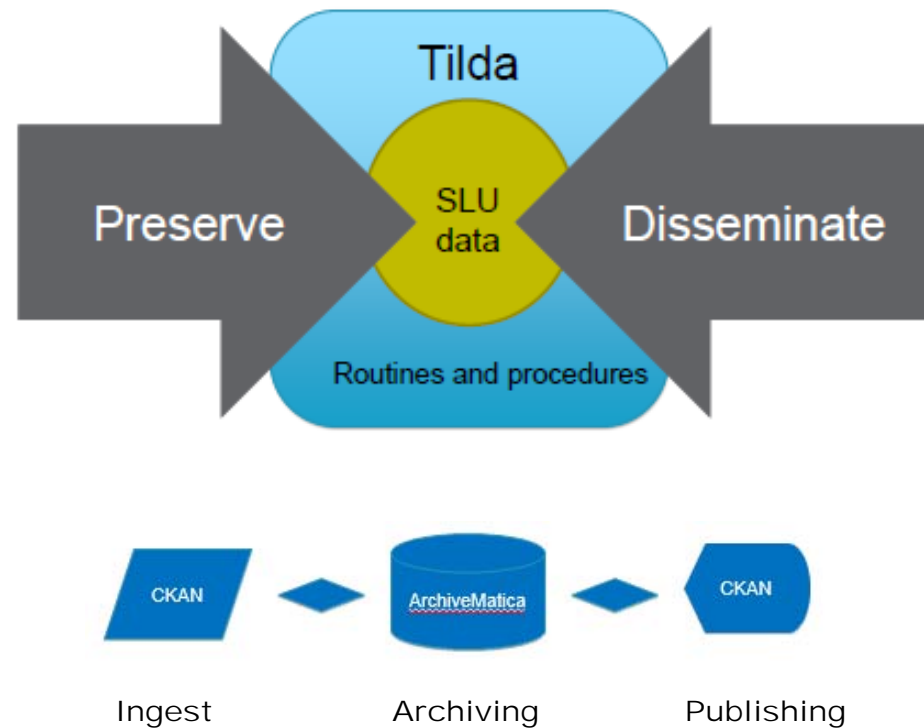
Benefits

For researchers:

Solid infrastructure to refer to in grant applications and support in data management early on and in the long term.

For SLU:

Compliance with legal requirements on archiving and long term preservation and access to research data. Safeguard for the integrity, reliability and authenticity of research. Visibility of research and environmental data. Reusability and citability of publicly funded research.



Digital Curation Unit (DCU)

Joint university unit to manage Tilda processes: Support for digital archiving and publishing of research data. Cooperation between library, administrative units and data producers.

Outcome

Uniform and clear routines and methods for data management. Manual and automatic registration of metadata. Links between metadata, publications and datasets. Exchange of metadata with external systems and portals.
