SciLifeLab Data Repository

The Science for Life Laboratory Data Repository is intended for use by researchers at Swedish academic institutions working in life science.

Files can be published openly, under embargo or under restricted access.



FEGA Sweden

The Federated European Genome-

phenome Archive Sweden is a national repository for making research data containing sensitive personal data available.

The main focus is on genomics data, but other types of life science data can also be accepted.

SND DORIS

In the Swedish National Data Service researchers can describe and share research data from all disciplines.

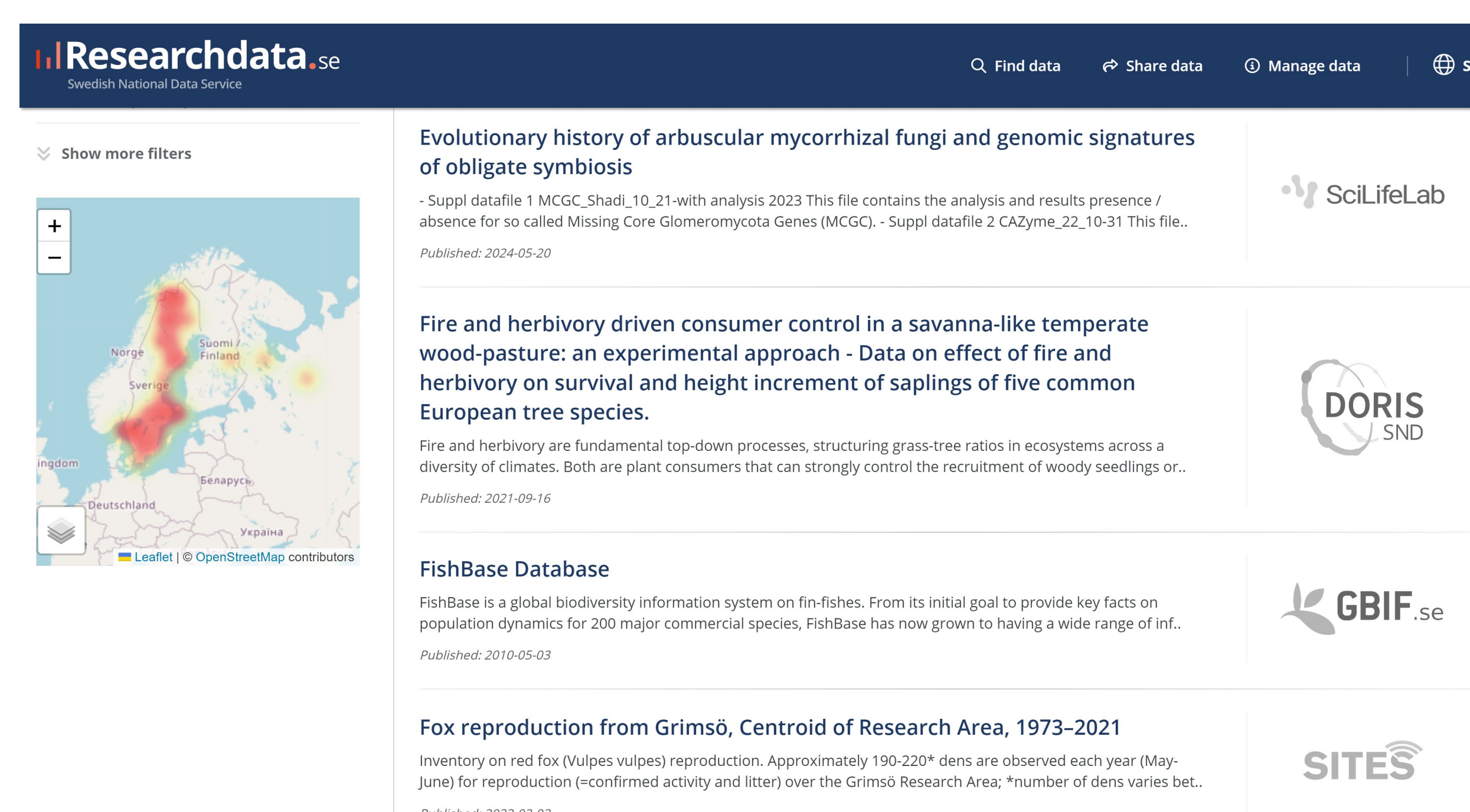
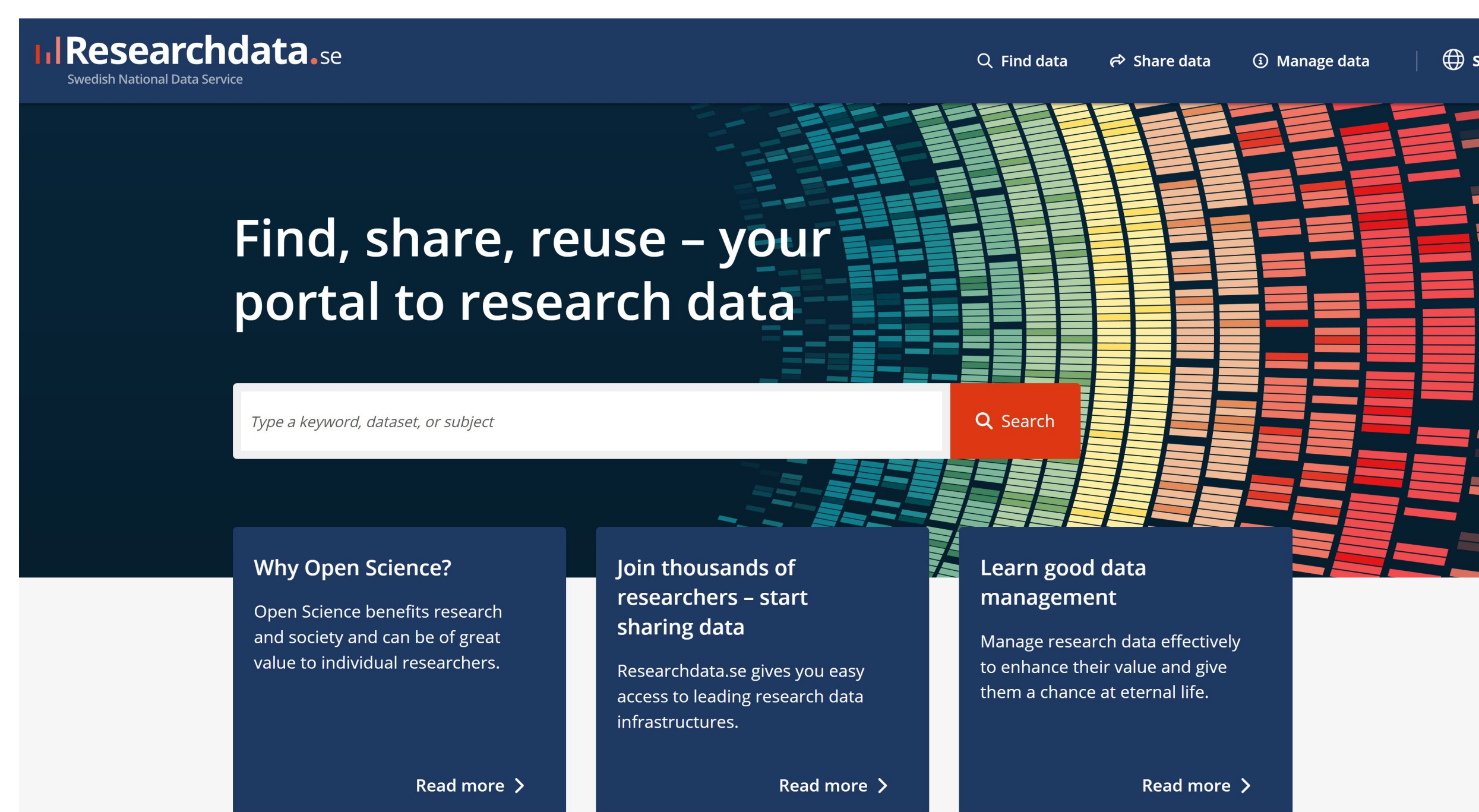
Data are published as open as possible. Protected data can be shared with restricted access. DORIS also supports reviewer-only access to data during the review process of an article.



SITES Data Portal

The Swedish Infrastructure for Ecosystem Science is a network of stations across Sweden enabling field-based research, and providing long-term data, on terrestrial and freshwater ecosystems.

SITES offers researchers using the infrastructure to upload project specific data, open access or with embargo.



Bolin Centre Database

The database publishes data from scientists at the Bolin Centre for Climate Research and their collaborators, as well as data related to climate and the Earth system from scientists at Stockholm University.

All data are made openly available.

SBDI



The Swedish Biodiversity Data Infrastructure hosts biodiversity data about plants, animals and fungi and their habitats from e.g. observation data, museum collections, and molecular data.

All data are freely available for research. Sensitive data may be published as openly as possible, as restricted as necessary.

GBIF Sweden

The Global Biodiversity Information Facility facilitates the publication and sharing of biodiversity data, including species observations, collection data from natural history museums, genetic data and ecological surveys and inventories.

All data are freely available for research and analysis.
