#### SciLifeLab Data Repository


The Science for Life Laboratory Data Repository is intended for use by researchers at Swedish academic institutions working in life science.

The Swedish Biodiversity Data Infrastructure hosts biodiversity data about plants, animals and fungi and their habitats

containing sensitive personal data available.

The main focus is on genomics data, but other types of life science data can also be accepted.

## **SND DORIS**

In the Swedish National Data Service researchers can describe and share research data from all disciplines.

Data are published as open as possible. Protected data can be shared with restricted

#### **SITES Data Portal**

The Swedish Infrastructure for Ecosystem Science is a network of stations across Sweden enabling fieldbased research, and providing long-term data, on terrestrial and freshwater ecosystems.

SITES offers researchers using the infrastructure to upload project specific data, open access or with embargo.
